

Each half term, your child will come home with their class curriculum overview. These are also on our school website on your child's class page.


This will give you all the information you need to know about what your child is covering that half term.

Club numerous times a week. We also encourage children to read an 'actual' reading book too and 5 dojo points are up for grabs if your child has read 5 times during the week.


Your child also has access to our class library and the whole school library which is undergoing a revamp this year so watch this space for new furniture, books and comfy places to sit and read!



Phonics Screening Check

The phonics screening check will take place during the summer term.

The children will be asked to read 40 words some of which will be made up alien words.



Things to work on at home



- Correct formation of upper and lower case letters and digits.
- Reading and spelling first 100 high frequency words
- Spelling the days of the week.
- Spelling numbers to 20 (words)
- Counting to and recognising all numbers to 100
- Counting in 2's 5's and 10's

Snack

Reception and Key Stage 1 classes include a morning break time snack of fruit or vegetables for all children. We take part in the Government initiative to provide all infants with free fruit and vegetables during the day. Key Stage 2 children are encouraged to bring in a healthy snack.



Many children bring a packed lunch to school. Parents are requested not to send in foods such as thickly covered chocolate biscuits or any foods which are high in sugar, fat or salt. We also insist that nut or nut products (although they can be very healthy) are not included in a child's packed lunch because of the danger to other children with allergies.

Water for All

Water is freely available throughout the school day to all members of the school community. Children may drink water at any time during the day using a clean bottle brought in from home on a daily basis.
