# Behaviour at Beaumont



- ▶ We use a “Good to be Green” system to promote positive behaviour.
- ▶ At Beaumont, we have three rights; The right to learn, the right to be safe & the right to be respected.
- ▶ We have superhero characters that promote the whole child! Each week we focus on a different character and have a celebration assembly where a child will receive a certificate and a badge.
- ▶ Dojos - 50 dojos the children will receive a head teacher sticker from Mrs Postle
- ▶ Bill the bear - class mascot which will be sent home on a Friday.
- ▶ Reading and maths award

# How to help at home

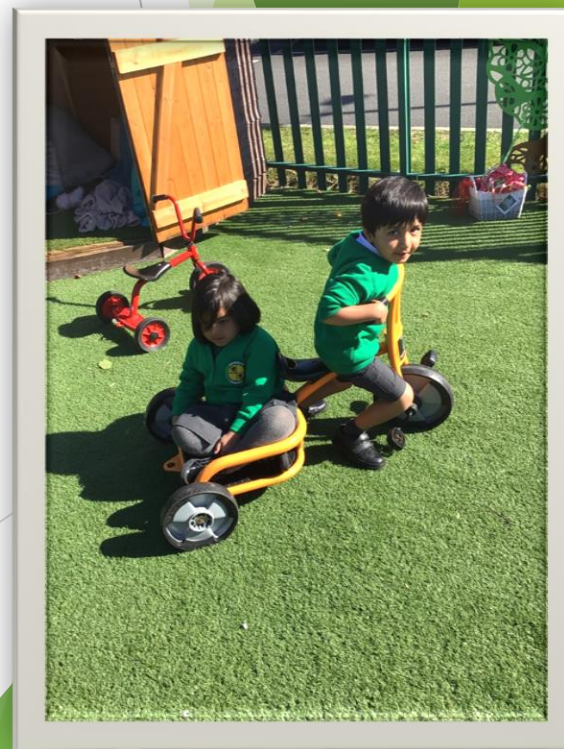
- ▶ You will receive a weekly newsletter containing information about what your child has been doing that week and what is coming up - uploaded onto class dojo.
- ▶ Time to talk - learning conversations/curiosity question
- ▶ Home Learning activities - Sent out on a Wednesday please upload any work onto class dojo by the following Wednesday.
- ▶ Reading with your child - if your child reads 5 times or more at home per week they will receive 5 dojos.
- ▶ Books to be sent into school on a Monday so we can hear your child read/change reading books.
- ▶ Please don't forget to sign your child's reading record.
- ▶ Bug club - log in details (purple mash username and password&initials)
- ▶ School Jam log ins will be sent home with your child





# P.E.

- ▶ The children are lucky as they have access to so many physical activities both in our inside classroom and outside classroom.
- ▶ We have a PE slot every Tuesday afternoon with Mr Chadwick.
- ▶ No jewellery including earrings. Please remove on PE days.
- ▶ The children should come into school wearing their PE kits/black trainers.





## Bumps and scrapes

- ▶ It is normal for your child to have the odd bump or fall.
- ▶ If your child has received a bump to the head or a more serious injury, a member of staff will contact you.

# Home time



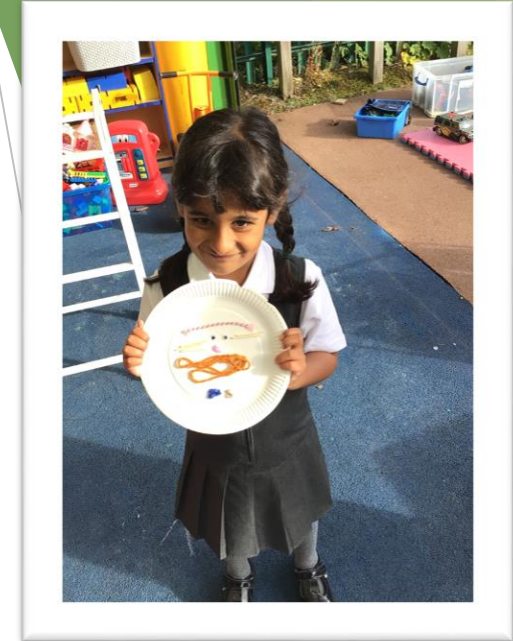
- ▶ Please make sure you contact the school office if a different person is picking up your child at home time so they can let us know.
